

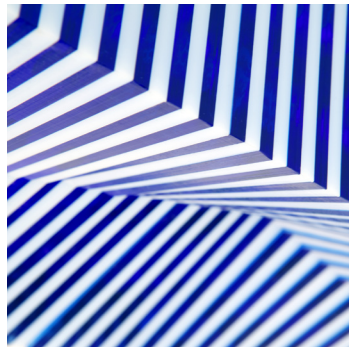


JOSHUA BLANK

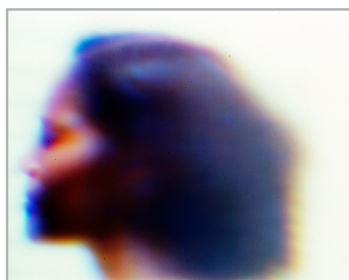


JOSHUA DUDLEY GREER

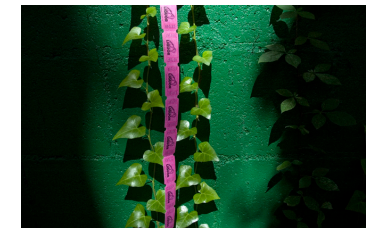


LAURA NOEL

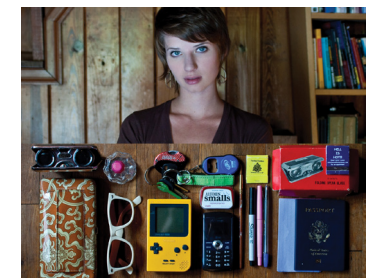


JASON TRAVIS
